Conditions for Submission

- Only the papers of the abstracts submitted to the 5th ECREA Conference, in Lisbon, will be accepted for review.
- The paper should be written in English, carefully reviewed. Automatic translation is not accepted.
- A single text file must be submitted without author identification for the blind peer-review.
- It is the responsibility of the authors to obtain copyright for the use of images, tables or graphs.

Review and Publication Process

Paper is sent to 2 reviewers for review. The reviewers’ recommendations determine whether a paper will be accepted, accepted but subjected to change and resubmission or rejected. For papers that require changes, the same reviewers will ensure if the quality of the revised paper is acceptable.

Manuscript Preparation

- Full papers should have **5,000 to 8,000** words, including title, footnotes and references. Should also include an abstract of no more than 200 words and up to 5 keywords.
- Manuscripts should be typed **double-spaced** on standard pages (A4), font **Times New Roman 12 pt.**
- **Figures, tables and artwork** should be provided at the end of the manuscript, on separate sheets.
- Electronic documents should be sent in Word (Windows or Mac OS). Graphics should be inserted in the Word text, in JPEG or TIFF format, with a resolution of at least 300 dpi.
- Any **note** must be listed at the end of the document and will be counted within the character's limit.
- **Citations or references** to authors and works should follow the following guidelines: (Berten, 2001); (Winseck & Cuthbert, 1997); (Gudykunst et al., 1996), (Berten, 2001: 99).
- The **reference list** should be placed at the end of the article, it should be sorted alphabetically, and should contain only the works in the text. Page numbers of the references should be provided for journal articles or work sections. Reference URLs should be provided when available.
